European Court of Justice, judgement of 26 October 2023, C-307/22 · The right to obtain a (first) copy pursuant to Art. 15 (3) GDPR can neither be made dependent on a justification nor on a fee; no negative effect of a motivation outside Recital 63 sentence 1 GDPR; no final clarification of the question if section 630g (2) 2 Civil Code [Bürgerliches Gesetzbuch] can be based on Art. 23 (1) (i) GDPR; continuation of jurisdiction on the right to obtain a copy of personal data in context. | https://curia.europa.eu

High Administrative Court of Bavaria, order of 4 September 2023, 4 ZB 23.1056 • The authorisation to adopt statutes in Art. 24 (4) (1) Bavarian Municipal Code [Gemeindeordnung] (in the version applicable until 31 December 2023) provides a lawful legal basis pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (1) (e), (3) GDPR for the use of electronic water meters with radio function; the right to object under Art. 21 (1) GDPR does not cover mere preparatory measures for processing personal data. https://www.gesetze-bayern.de
